The Young and Pregnant Parenting service provides case management, secondary consultation, and a drop off service for young parents (16 to 25 years of age) and their children who are at risk of or are experiencing homelessness. Support to young people:- Aged between 16 to 25 years of age who are pregnant or parents- Who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, have recently been homeless or who are experiencing disadvantage- Who live or have connection to the north and west areas of Melbourne. Case management:Our Outreach case management worker provides support to young people to:- Obtain housing- Access baby goods- Gain parenting information including childhood development- Access required registrations such as birth registration and Centrelink family payment link to specialist services and community supports. Drop in service:

/>Young women who are pregnant or who are young parents can drop in at Frontyard Youth Services (19 King Street). The drop-in service (dependent on worker availability) can provide information, support and links to other parenting supports.
